Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2024-25 educational progress for Ridgeview Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about accountability, student assessment, and teacher quality. For the 2025-26 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student group in 2024-25. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had at least one student group performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, failed to exit CSI status in 2024-25, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no status label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Ridgeview Elementary School reviews its student outcome data three times a year and prepares grade level plans to help current students increase their achievement scores as measured on the Acadience Reading tests. Students who are identified as needing additional reading help are given more time and targeted instruction. Their progress is monitored and adjustments in instruction are made until the students reach the desired outcome.

Ridgeview has also recently adopted a new Tier I literacy resources to help us align our instruction and has hired an instructional coach to provide support for our professional staff.

State law requires that we also report additional information.



1. Ridgeview serves the students of the Sparta Area School District in grades Kindergarten, first and second grade.
2. Ridgeview continues to grow in the use of the Mulit-Tier Systems of Support Process (MTSS). Reading teams have been added to the already established behavior teams to increase the effectiveness of our systems.
3. Ridgeview follows the Common Core State Standards and uses common Tier I, Tier II and Tier III math and literacy resources across all grade levels. You can assess a copy of the curriculum and a description of its implementation by emailing steve.johnson2@spartaschools.org
